Silent Soldier Sculpture

This Royal British Legion figure, for which Cllr Jeet Bains kindly volunteered funding at our last meeting, is now on order. The cost had increased to £250. When it arrives ASPRA has permission to install it at Blackhorse Corner, near the Noticeboard, from Chris McAvoy, Croydon Council's Environmental Safety Manager, who has also approved the Poppies. Dave Lee has kindly signed the required Indemnity Form, on behalf of the ASPRA Committee, to ensure that we are covered for this under our Zurich Public Liabilities Insurance Policy, which he also kindly organised & recently renewed. Hopefully the sculpture can be safely placed on site early, in advance of the November Centenary Commemorations, if Members approve. (?)
