

Addiscombe Recreation Ground Update

The gardens have mostly survived our hot dry summer. Thank you to everyone who has helped with the watering. The gardening group are planning to arrange another community event soon.

The tennis courts have been refurbished and are now managed by GLL who have the leisure contract for Croydon. They are looking at the possibility of reopening the toilets during times when their tennis is in session. We have been assured that we will not lose access to our outside tap so our water supply will continue. They also considered that we may wish to manage the toilets when we have volunteers working on the gardens but it was felt that our community events are on an ad-hoc basis about every couple of months for two hours so not really worth it.

The park entrance in Sefton Road has been closed due to one of the pillars being dislodged. In the past only the problem gate/pillar has been sectioned off so still allowing entry. Perhaps the councillors can advise why this time it is both gates and taking so long to repair.

There continues to be a problem with opening park gates. No one seems to be prepared to report the problem each time it happens and this is perhaps because there is no phone number/s displayed.
